

Home Learning activities Year 1

Reading

- Read and share books together every day.
- Talk about the story, what happened and what might happen next.
- Find out new things using information books, using the contents and index pages to find what you are looking for.

Phonics

- Sounding out to read words ready for the phonics check in June.

- www.letters-and-sounds.com use Phase 4 games and Phase 5 words to practise.

Science

We have been learning about animals in our Science topic.

- Research their favourite animal
- Create a fact file showing their research, including:
 - which animal class it belongs to (mammal, fish, bird, etc.)
 - habitat
 - diet
 - appearance and features
 - draw a picture of the animal and label it
 - keep handwriting neat. Remember to use capital letters, full stops and question marks.

Maths

- Count to 50 and 100 in ones, twos, fives and tens.
- Practise adding and subtracting
- Telling the time - keep a diary of main activities including times
