- Do some cooking and weigh the ingredients



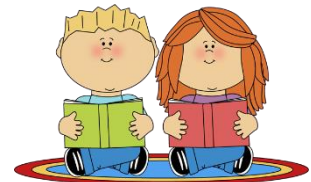
## RE: Holy Week and Easter

## English
